

PCMA for SAP S/4HANA 2020 and 2021 SP1

Payment Card Management and Analytics (PCMA) is the component used to integrate SAP to the XiPay B2B Gateway for authorization and settlement processing and provides the B2B Receivables, Analytics and Reconciliation value added solutions within SAP.

Problems Addressed

5.4.0 Problems Addressed

Reauthorize & Release Billing Document: Changes were made to ensure credit memos are processed.

5.4.1 Problems Addressed

Repeat Settlement: Changes were made to address errors occurring when running Repeat Settlement with certain processing parameters.

5.4.2 Problems Addressed

Open AR and Partial Payments: ALV not displaying properly when 'Display Partial Payments' processing option was selected.

5.4.3 Problems Addressed

Web AR and echeck: Changes were made to ensure tokenized echeck details are updated in FPLTC and BSEGC.

Compatibility and Basic Requirements

- SAP S/4HANA 2020 and 2021 SP1
 - Transport zip filename: **PCMA_SAP_S4HANA2020-2021SP1.zip**
- Paymetric SAP components:
 - PAS – 2.10.0
NOTE: This is the version tested; however, it should be backward compatible and forward compatible with the upcoming 2.11.0 release.
 - XiSecure SAP ECC IK – 3.5.0

NOTE: PCMA version 5.4.0 and higher are not backward compatible with S/4HANA versions prior to 2020. See [PCMA Releases](#) for other supported versions.

Install and Configuration Notes

New Installs

Install 5.4.0 first then the remaining patch transports in order. Do not skip a transport.

Refer to the *XiPay Platform SAP S4 Integration Guide* for install, setup, and integration details.

Upgrades

If you are on a version prior to the latest full transport, install the full one and all subsequent patch transports.

- If you are on a version later than the latest full transport, verify all patch transports between your version and the latest are installed before installing the latest.

- For ALL upgrades, even if PCMA IMG modifications are not required for the upgrade, you must execute the PCMA IMG transaction code (/n/PMPAY/PIMG) to initiate the objects from the upgrade.
- When importing the transport(s):
 - The '**overwrite existing objects**' flag should be selected since many of these are existing objects.
 - Allow sufficient time for each transport to complete before loading the next one to prevent syntax errors.
- Any custom changes (including userexits configured in the PCMA IMGs) should be evaluated and may need to be replicated in the new later versions of these userexits. There may be new userexits that were not in your previous version - please review the documentation for details.
- If upgrading from a previous/older version of PCMA, it is advised you recreate any custom userexits that are configured in /PMPAY/PIMG. They should be recreated based on the new sample default userexits that are provided.
